Chinua achebe was a Nigerian novelist who became famous by writing " things fall apart". in the igbo town of ogidi in eastern Nigeria achebe was born in November 16, 1930. After completing the university achebe was joined the Nigerian broadcasting corporation in 1961 as a director of external broadcasting. He served in that role until 1966.

The 1960s proved to be a productive period for Achebe. In 1961, he married Christie Chinwe Okoli, with whom he would go on to have four children, and it was during this decade he wrote the follow-up novels to *Things Fall Apart*: *No Longer at Ease* (1960) and *Arrow of God* (1964), as well as *A Man of the People* (1966). All address the issue of traditional ways of life coming into conflict with new, often colonial, points of view. The things fall apart is a creation of pre colonial literature. How a nation colonized we can understand it by reading things fall apart. We can say that it is a guideline for the clolonizers and colonized also.it teaches how to colonized a nation and how to escape from the colonization.

The things fall apart is a novel which was published in 1958. The protagonist of the novel was a igbo man who was living in Nigeria with his family during the later of 19<sup>th</sup> century. Okonkwo is a important part of the fictional village umuofia, he is a farmer and a famous wresling

But in the other hand, the Christian missionaries tried to convience people of the okonkwos mothers tribe that their Christianity is greater than the primitive religion and the customary laws, norms and values. We know colonialism make people feel inferior to the colonizer as they can use them as a slave. So in the things fall apart missionary people tried to push their culture and others things into the primitive nation. they targeted the weak men from the tribe and convert them in the Christianity. In their frist attempt they succeed to transforms peoples religion. And this is the main disaster which is responsible for destroying a primitive pure cultural community.
